

Winnipeg Winter Club Tennis Policy - Revised March 2017

The objective of this policy is to provide fair access to all Winnipeg Winter Club members and to ensure the highest possible utilization of the courts. Tennis Department programming takes priority over all other court bookings.

Prime Time runs from October 1st, through May 31st, as follows:

Monday through Friday - Noon to 1:00 PM & 5:00 to 9:00 PM

Saturday & Sunday: 9:30 AM to 7:00 PM

Shortened Holiday Days – **ALL DAY**

1. RULES

- a. Bookings slots are: maximum 1 hour for singles, maximum 1.5 hours for doubles, and maximum 1.5 hours for Private or Semi Private lessons.
- b. Only one booking per member allowed during prime time (includes lessons, Permanent Court Time - PCT, practice and casual play).
- c. No phantom bookings: Names on the schedule must match players on court before play begins.
- d. Juniors (under 18 years of age) can only book prime time slots on the same day and through the front desk.
- e. An adult member can book a prime time slot to play with a junior. The adult member must make the booking.
- f. Members cannot play in consecutive time periods and must leave a minimum one-hour gap between slots. This includes league play, PCT, practice time, lessons and casual bookings (excludes clinics).
- g. During prime time, ball machine use is allowed only on court one, with a minimum of two players.
- h. Members may continue to play after their allowed time as long as the court they are on is not booked.
- i. Members cannot leave the court and re-book once their time expires. If there is an open court, members can shift to that court and continue to play until the next booking.
- j. Walk-on members can book an open slot through the front desk and bump continuation players.
- k. Members of clubs affiliated with WWC are allowed walk-on bookings only.
- l. Late arrivals are allowed a 20 minute grace period, after which the court becomes available to other members.
- m. No-shows are an infraction. Court cancellations are required.
- n. Members must book immediately before or after another booked slot or leave a minimum 60 minute gap. Singles or doubles are allowed to book in a 90 minute gap.

2. PENALTIES

- a. Tennis Policy infractions will result in a written warning.
- b. A second infraction will result in loss of casual play and booking privileges for 2 weeks from the date of the written notification.
- c. A third infraction will result in total loss of access to the tennis courts for 2 weeks from the date of written notification.
- d. Appeals can be made in writing to the Tennis Committee at tenniswwc@gmail.com.
- e. Warnings will be removed from member records after 6 months.

PLEASE NOTE: REGARDLESS OF WHICH MEMBER IS SPONSORING A GUEST, THE SAME GUEST MAY ONLY ATTEND THE CLUB TWICE PER MONTH TO A MAXIMUM OF 10 VISITS PER YEAR. ALL GUESTS MUST CHECK IN AT FRONT RECEPTION PRIOR TO PLAYING IN ORDER FOR GUEST FEE TO BE PROCESSED.
